LAEP provides funds to participating public postsecondary educational institutions to offer eligible students opportunities to earn money to help pay their educational costs while gaining career-related experience in their fields of study at:

- **Research centers and institutions operated by public postsecondary educational institutions providing direct opportunities to participate in research**
- Public schools
- Nonsectarian, nonpolitical organizations that are capable of providing full-time employment or connection to another employer able to provide full-time employment after graduation



Employer Eligibility

Any on campus college or department can participate if they have a research-based position.

Research positions will be defined as jobs where students have direct opportunities to participate in academic or scientific research by either conducting and/or assisting their research supervisor/mentor.

Research positions may have other tasks/assignments but the majority of the role must be research based (greater than 50%)

Important Dates & Deadlines

- **July 1, 2023:** LAEP eligibility opens for Summer 2023 (start of new AY 23-24)
- **September 1, 2023:** LAEP eligibility period concludes for Summer 2023
- **September 18, 2023:** Work-Study eligibility period begins for Fall 2023.
- **December 11-21, 2023:** Winter Break.
- **March 25- 29, 2024:** Spring Break.
- **June 24, 2024:** Work-Study eligibility period concludes



Student Eligibility

- Undergraduate students only
- Demonstrate financial need
- Be work-study eligible (based on FAFSA results)
- Student will see these on their financial aid offer and/or on their Work-Study Eligibility Notification
- Enrolled in at least half-time units
- Be considered a CA resident
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress
- Eligibility to work in the US
- Self-certify that this role would help them with their future career goals
