# FACT OR MYTH #1

The vast majority of students find themselves in a career field related to their major.

# MYTH





According to data from Resume Builder, a national survey conducted found that 47% of college-educated workers reported not working in the field of their major. The survey also showed that employment in field of study varies by major.

# FACT OR MYTH #2

Declaring a major before 2nd year still allows students to graduate in four years.







About one third of students change their major at least once. Data shows students who made a FINAL decision by the end of their 2<sup>nd</sup> year were still able to graduate in four years.

- Identifying a major that fits interests and skills
