- Most *recent* degree first
- Dates on the right-hand side to balance page
- **Include** minors, double majors, concentrations, etc.
- Only list schools from which you receive a degree (high school can be used until around third year)GPA is optional

### Sample job description

### Data Science Leadership Development Program (Entry-Level Position with a Science Services Company):

The DSLDP prepares participants for roles of increasing responsibility through a combination of rotational assignments, structured learning, formalized feedback, and mentoring. Program participants will have the opportunity to interact with senior Data Science and IT leaders and participate in various key Data Science initiatives. Program participants will have 2 one-year rotation assignments during the two-year program. As part of the rotational program, candidates may rotate through locations including but not limited to: Massachusetts, Pennsylvania, California, etc. Geographic flexibility is required both during and upon completion of the program.

- Students completing a Bachelor's degree; preferred majors: Mathematics, Data Science, Computer Science, Computational and Data Science & Engineering

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## Applicant Tracking System (ATS) What is it?

Software for recruiters and employers to track candidates throughout the recruiting and hiring process. This software can come equipped with capabilities ranging from simple database functionality to a full-service suite of tools that makes it easy for businesses of any size to filter, manage, and analyze candidates.

"As of 2019, 99% of the Fortune 500 companies used an ATS in their hiring process.<sup>1</sup> These companies already have the brand recognition and resources to compete for top talent; an ATS can level the playing field by creating better, quicker access to candidates."

## Applicant Tracking System (ATS) Why is it important?

These tracking systems will likely be the first impression of your resume. This highlights the importance of tailoring your resume and incorporating key: skills, action verbs, and language in your resume to be industry specific to a position.

- Weaving in recurring preferred qualifications/skills
- Tailor your current skills and experiences to match the job description

## Step 3:

- 1. Resumes depending on major can vary industry to industry and Career Specialists are your guide to determine what is the most relevant
- 2. Creating a resume requires you to consider what skills you'd like to showcase AND prioritize what employers want to see
- 3. Formatting and specific content on the resume will be considered when employers review resumes so **ALWAYS** refer to the job description
- 4. Practice makes progress and if you are struggling with editing your experience section, consider coming to Drop-ins to have your resume reviewed
