




Handshake — Events Page

When should I visit the Career Center?

Start as early as your freshman year.

We recommend for students to interact with the Career Center early on to allow students to be more prepared (ie. Resume writing, Cover Letter writing, Interview preparation, where to find jobs, how to apply, etc.).

Career Center is here to help students.



Will the Career Center find me a job?

Simple answer: No

Explanation: we do not help students find jobs because we are not the recruiters or employers. But we assist with the process to helps students figure out their future careers and prospective jobs.



Do career assessments tell me what career I should choose?

No, career assessments are just suggestions to give students different possibilities based on student preferences of work environments, personality, and work habits, but the end decision will still be up to the student.
