## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Does the Career Center find jobs for my students?

- Not a placement agency: We do not directly place students in jobs.
- Empowerment through education: We provide resources and developmental education to help students acquire the skills necessary to secure their own career paths.
- Lifelong skills: Our goal is to teach essential marketplace skills that will serve them long after they graduate.

### What kind of employer access do you provide?

- All Majors: We bring a great variety of employers to campus in-person and virtually each year.
- In the Classroom: We invite industry partners and alumni to come to classrooms to speak about career paths with your students.
- UCR Handshake: This is the exclusive database where students can search for jobs, internships, and work-study opportunities.

### How do career assessments actually help my students?

- Inform, not dictate: Assessments help individuals inform their decisions, but they do not measure education, skill, or aptitude.
- Collaboration is key: We advise students to use these results in collaboration with workshops, counseling, and advice from faculty, friends/family and mentors.

### When is the best time for me to refer a student to the Career Center?

- Encourage early engagement: We recommend students begin using our services during their 1st year on campus.
- Developmental approach: Because we operate on a developmental model, we provide a full range of services for students from their first year through graduate school.
- Skill-building: Attending workshops and events early helps students begin to develop a career focus.

### Can a Career Center staff member present a workshop for my students?

- Career Center staff and peer advisors are available to deliver career presentations to campus groups, classes, and student organizations. Submit your request at least one month before the desired program date. We require participation of at least 15 students.

### How can the Career Center support me as a staff member?

- We partner with you to guide students through major exploration, decision-making, and post-graduation planning. Career specialists provide in-depth support on resumes, internships, job search, and career planning.
