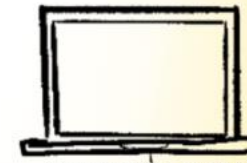

Master-Level

- Master of Arts (MA)
- Master of Education (MEd)
- Master of Science (MS)
- Master of Business Administration (MBA)

Doctoral (academic and professional)

- Doctor of Education (EdD)
- Doctor of Philosophy (PhD)
- Doctor of Medicine (MD)
- Juris Doctor (JD)
- PharmD

Others

- Certificates
- Post-doctoral
- Combination (MD/PhD or MBA/JD)



Post-baccalaureate programs

What are they?

Great for...

- Career changers
- Improving academic standing before applying to grad programs
- Preparing to earn a second bachelor's degree

Considerations...

- Programs are not equal to graduate education, but are more advanced than a bachelor's degree
- Can be used to take pre-requisites for graduate or professional programs
- Typically 8-12 months

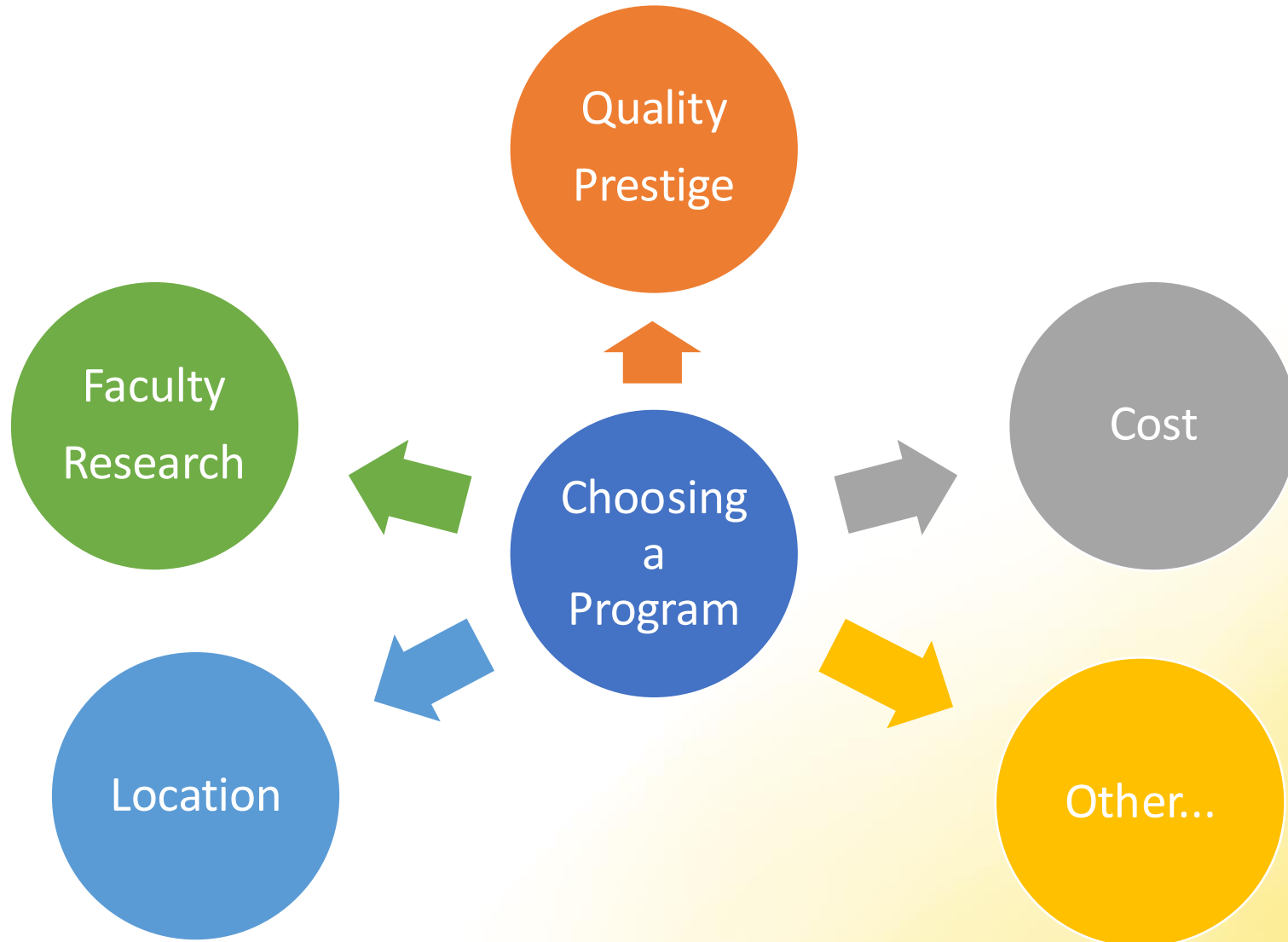

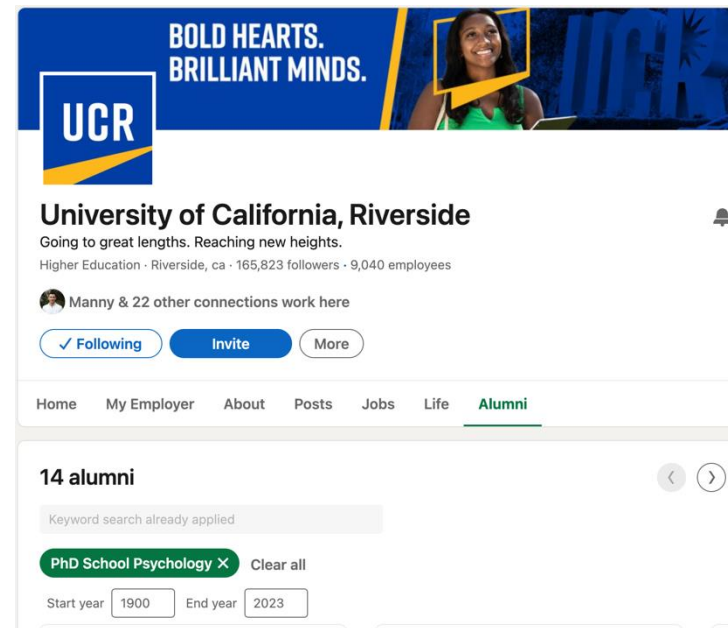
Program considerations

Get to Know the Programs



Get connected to programs' admissions:

- Find out what makes each program stand apart from each other
- Ask to get connected to current students of a program or alumni
- Make sure if a program is the right fit for you



Research Alumni of Programs on LinkedIn:

- Utilize the "Alumni" tab of different universities of interest
- Search for program names to find examples of current students / alumni
- Pay attention to experiences on alumni profiles
- Connect with people of interest to learn more about their career path

Schedule early enough to allow for scoring

Fees to take and to send scores

Personal Statements

Share motivation and preparation

Ask admissions representatives questions

Highlight unique qualities and career goals

Ask several weeks in advance

Provide resume and highlights

Writers should speak to academic preparedness and/or professional competence

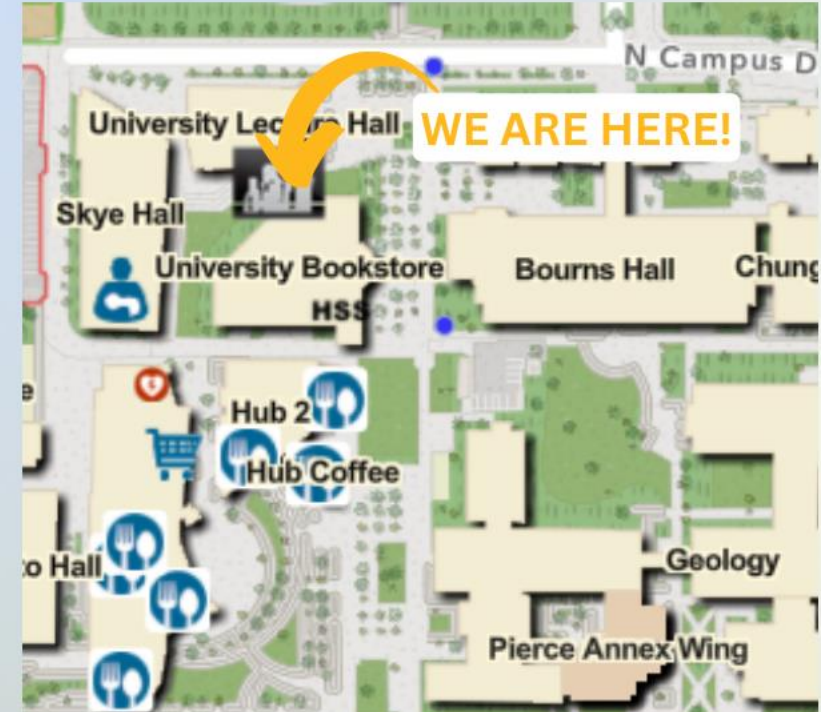
